CHALLENGE

Wearwell relies heavily upon shared data from and between various departments. Prior to partnering with CorVu, the amount of data grew beyond their ability to manage, and Wearwell experienced a lack of appropriate data visualization and time to generate reports. In fact, the IT department was burdened with requests to write specific reports for various departments. Additionally, current report writers did not provide the level of detail desired. Often, once requests were submitted and fulfilled, a need for further details was discovered. The result was a great amount of employee time spent finding needed data and generating substandard reports. Clearly, there had to be a better solution.

Wearwell sought a performance management software solution that every person, at every level, internally and externally could use. Additional requirements included providing supervisors with data for easy dissemination to representatives and distributors

without disrupting current systems. Furthermore, Wearwell searched for a software solution that had the flexibility to evolve with organization informational needs.

SOLUTION

Wearwell's search of several software solutions ended with CorManufacturing. Previous positive experiences lead Wearwell to include CorVu on their list of possible solutions. According to Randy Lyles, Director of Management Information Systems, “With Wearwell and CorVu working in tandem, we believed that immediate benefits would be seen.” As expected, CorVu had a timely and cost-effective implementation strategy for Wearwell. This strategy created eight dashboards, containing fifty-four Key Performance Indicators, spread across fourteen different organizational structures, in only twenty consulting days.

CorVu currently helps Wearwell distribute a high level of data with less time spent on generating and distributing each report. Furthermore, managers can access departmental reports each morning, as well as throughout the day, with the ability to drill into details when needed. CorManufacturing allows users to track and manage reports, keep on top of margins and new product development, raise inventory performance, and reach sales and unit goals.
